## Motor Vehicle Thefts down 40.9%

In light of the Project CLEAN initiative, the Allen Police Department is proud to announce that the year-to-date motor vehicle theft rate in the City of Allen has dropped by more than 40%.

According to Sgt. Jon Felty of the Community Relations Division, the number of stolen motor vehicles in the first six months of this year is down significantly from 44 vehicles to 26. Felty stated that this is due in part to the department's initiative to build relations between police officers and the community by educating the public on crime prevention.

Felty said, "One of our goals is to increase the number of Neighborhood Watch groups

in the community to help the public become more proactive in the prevention of crimes in their neighborhoods."
