



**ALLEN ADULT HOCKEY LEAGUE (AAHL)**  
D Division

The Allen Adult Hockey D Division (AAHL D) is designed for Novice level players 21 years of age and older. Although, some players may have 5+ years of playing experience (either as an adult or a youth), this experience is not to have exceeded the adult novice, or beginner youth levels. Some players may have high school experience. Players that have played competitive hockey (i.e. College, Juniors, etc..) or are playing in a league classified as "C" or higher will have to be evaluated prior to being added to the roster. The league emphasis will be to create a fun, enjoyable and competitive environment for players with average to above average skill abilities and a good understanding of team play.

**Age Requirements:**

All players must be 21 years of age or older

**Cost:**

- The cost for the AAHL D team will be \$5300 per team.
- Receive a reduced rate of \$4800 if team is paid in full before season begins.  
\*Coordinator are responsible for collecting and paying the team's league fee to the ACIR.

**League Format:**

- 16 Games + Playoff

**Game Format:**

- 3 Minute on-ice warm up
- 15-minute periods
- Clock Run Time Occurs when:
  - A) 6 goal or larger point difference in the 3<sup>rd</sup> period
  - B) Regardless of period, 15 called penalties during the game

**Overtime Format:**

- No game shall end in a tie at the end of regulation time of games. If the game is tied at end of 3<sup>rd</sup> period:
  1. Three on Three
  2. 5 minutes running clock (sudden death)
  3. Still tied at the end of OT, each team will be awarded 1 point each
  4. Four on Three will occur when a player receives a penalty during OT

**Roster:**

- ACIR does NOT form teams in this division.
- We only accept team registrations from a designated Team Coordinator.
- A team's roster shall be frozen on the fourth Monday, from start of season games (after the fourth game)
- Maximum 18 players will be allowed to dress out per game and one goaltender.
- Once the official rosters are entered [allenhockey.sportngin.com](http://allenhockey.sportngin.com) designated team coordinators may, in writing, challenge the advance skill levels of players listed on opponents' official rosters. (see rules for details)
- A team Roster will be required at the time of registration as well as each rostered player must complete an Individual Registration form, waiver and present USA Hockey Membership receipt. (see registration link).

USA Hockey Membership **REQUIRED**:

Every player that signs up to participate in the AAHL D must register through \*USA Hockey and submit a registration receipt to ACIR prior to the first session of each season. Please visit <http://usahockeyregistration.com> to complete the registration process. All participants must have a current USA Hockey membership throughout the entire season.

- 3.) Once you have completed the registration process write down your USA Hockey confirmation number and/or print the screen. You will need this to register for an Allen Adult Hockey League (include on registration form).

**\*Note:** The USA Hockey playing season dates are Sept 1 through Aug 31 of each year.
